He was immediately referred for further testing to Kitale Eye Unit, built by Operation Eyesight in 2012. Sure enough, the little boy had refractive error, meaning he simply needed eyeglasses. And thanks to the support of kind people like you, he received his new prescription eyeglasses at no cost to his family!

Now that he can see, Meshack is eagerly catching up with his studies, and hopes to become a doctor one day. He and his parents are so grateful for your support.

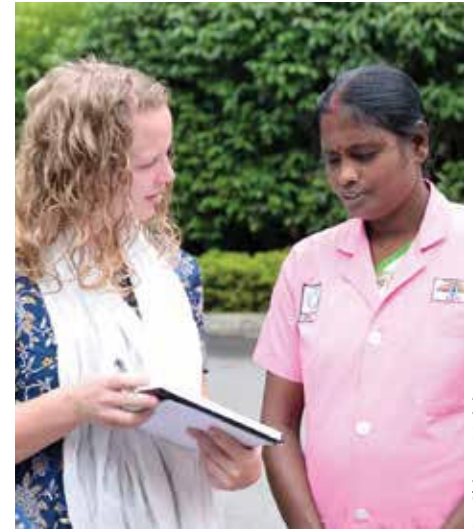

New data shows how far we've come

36 million people are blind



217 million other people have moderate to severe visual impairment



115 million people could be blind by 2050

In October, the World Health Organization released its latest research into the global number of people with blindness and visual impairment. Their estimate of 253 million people is both encouraging and a reminder of how much work we still have to do.

The good news? There are 90 million fewer people who are blind or visually impaired than were estimated, based on 1990 prevalence rates. That's better than expected and a huge success for the eye care community, including Operation Eyesight. **It couldn't have happened without our amazing donors!**

However, the total number of people with vision problems has continued to rise, up from 191 million in 1990. That means there's much more to be done. **We're counting on your continued support!**
