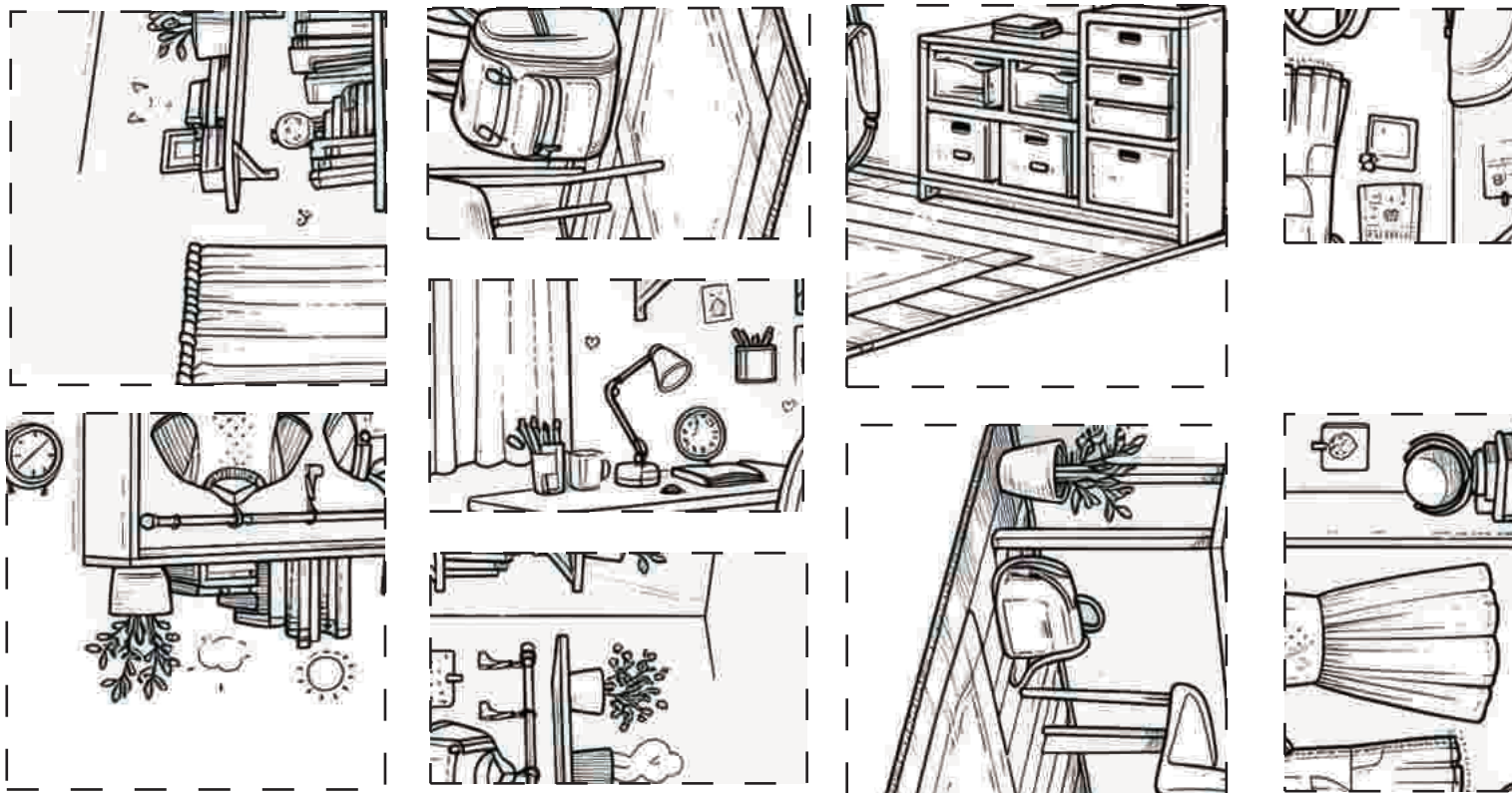


Iris rushes back to her bedroom to get ready to go to the eye doctor.

With the help of an adult, cut up the puzzle pieces from below and glue them in place in the squares on the next page.

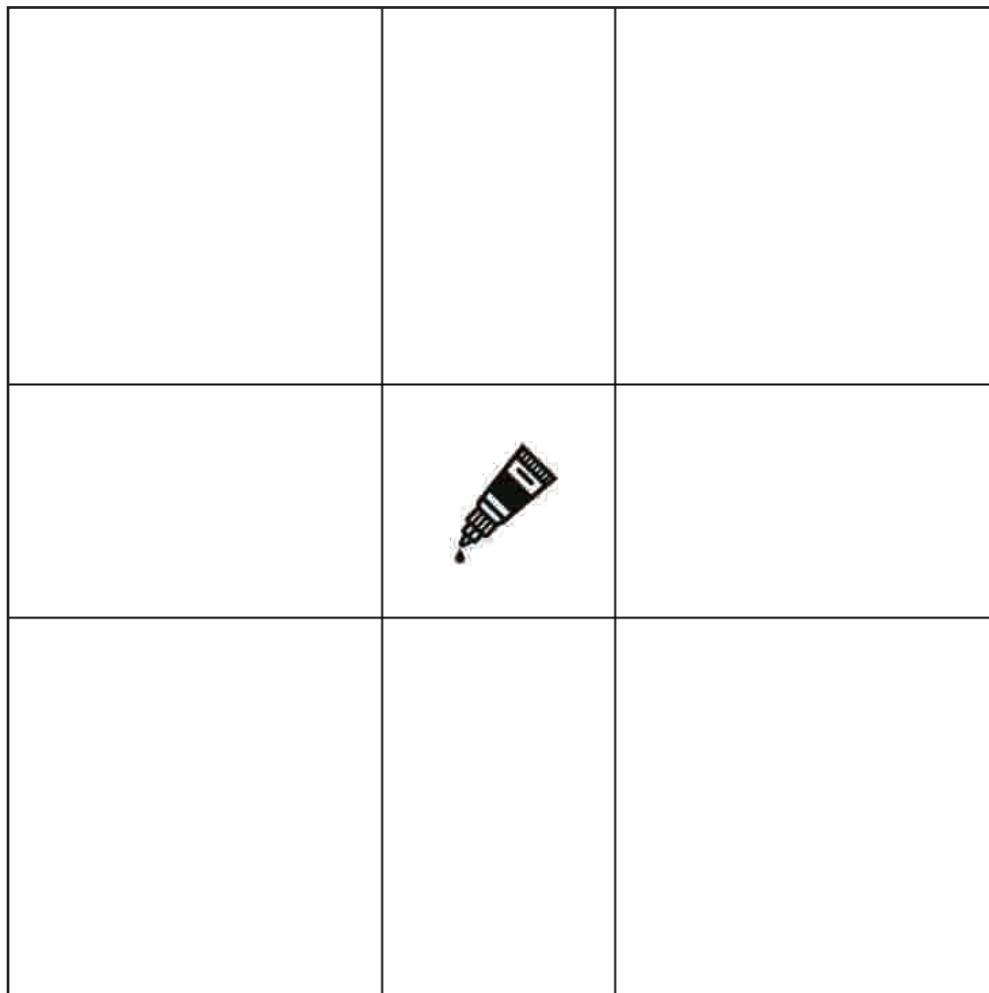

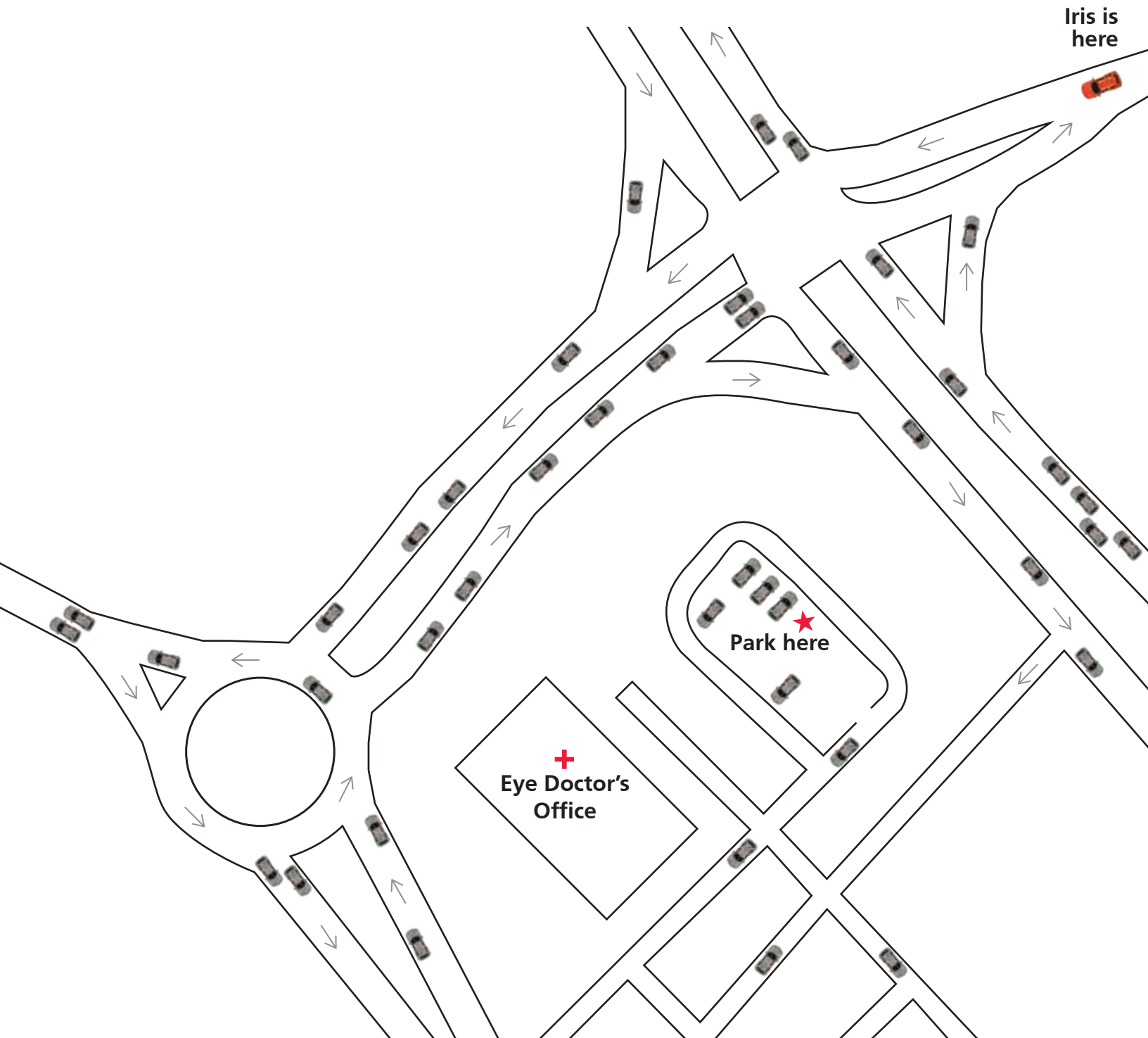

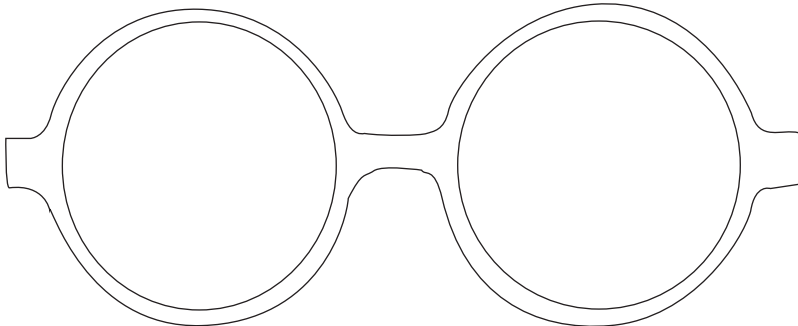
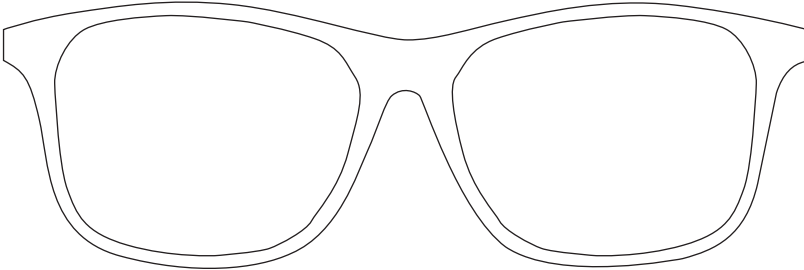
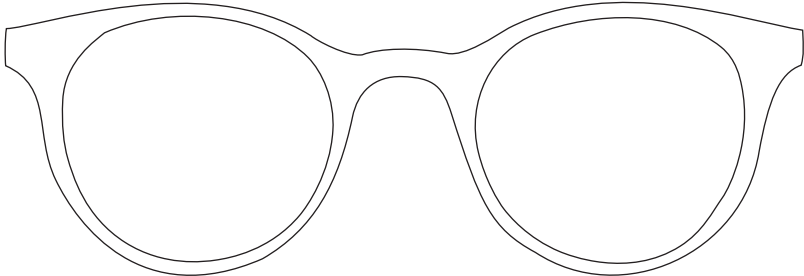
To find the correct lens for Iris' new glasses, the doctor asks her to look through a special machine and read the letters in front of her on the wall.

Get creative!**



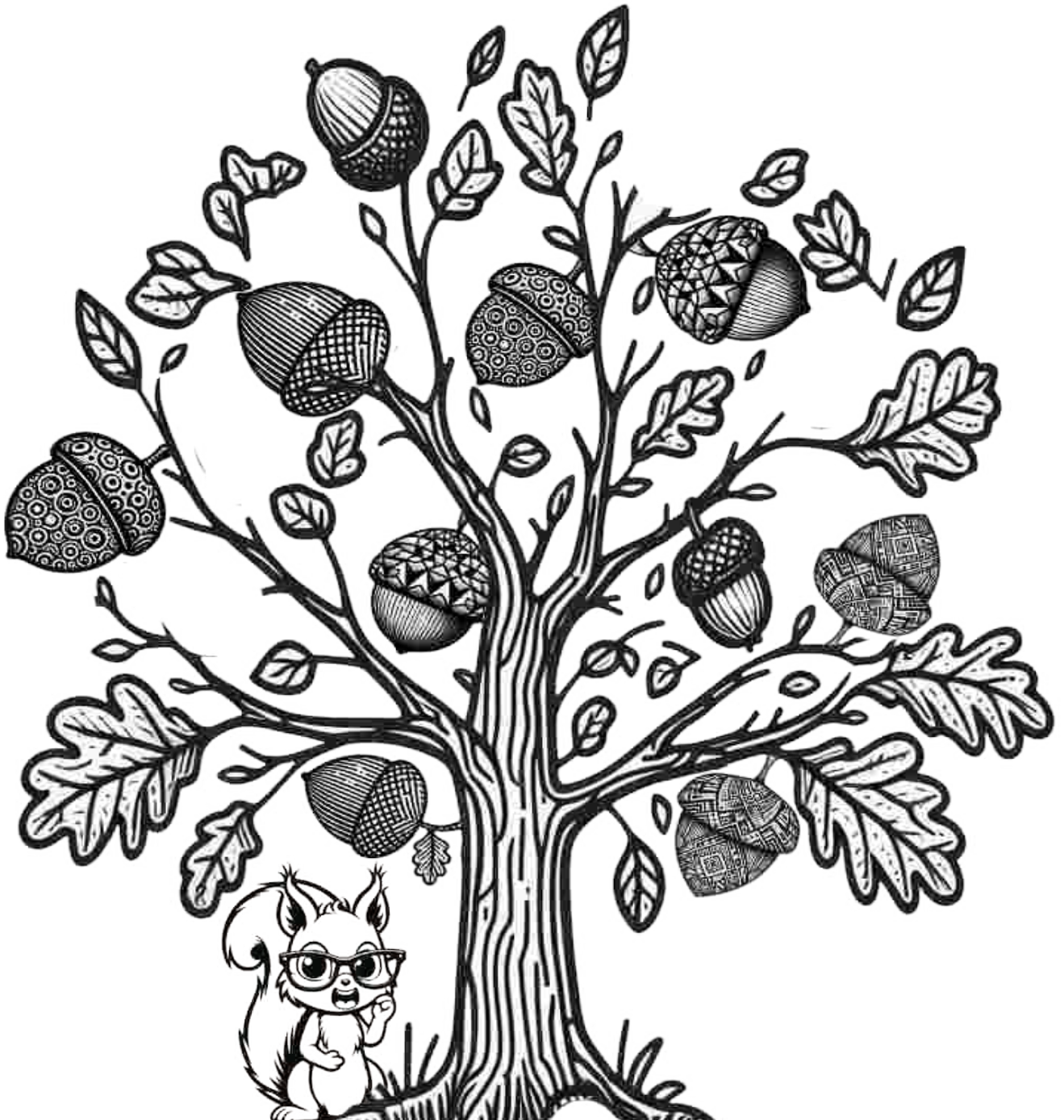
Look at Iris with her brand new eyeglasses!
